There will be ample horse water in camp, but please bring your own human water. We will have several outhouses at base camp, as well as at the vet check. Dogs are welcome in camp, on a leash. Please pick up after your dog. No dogs are allowed on trails. No dogs at the vet check.

**No smoking is allowed on the trails, and no fires or open flames in camp as this is a high fire danger area.**
